

Christmas Stocking Garland

Materials

- * Any oddments of DK yarn in three colours (Anna has used red, green and cream)
- * 4.5mm crochet hook
- * A tapestry needle

Learn to crochet your own Christmas stocking garland with the wonderful Anna Nikirowicz!

They could also make the perfect advent calendar – just cut numbers out of felt, stick one onto each stocking and insert chocolates or other small goodies. You can also hang the stockings individually on a tree as a charming decoration.

With the cream coloured yarn, work 6 dc into a adjustable ring, enclosing the tail as you work, pull tight on the tail to close up opening.

Round 1: 2 dc in every st to end. (12 sts)

Change to red yarn or green yarn

Rounds 2 to 7: 1 dc in every st to end.

Round 8: ch 6, miss next 6 sts, 1 dc in next 6 sts,

Round 9: 1 dc in next 6 ch, 1 dc in next 6 sts. (12 sts)

Round 10 to 12: 1 dc in every st to end.

Change to cream yarn

Round 12 to 13: 1 dc in every st to end.

Fasten off.

Heel

Join the cream yarn to first st on the foot part of heel opening.

Round 1: 1 dc in next 6 sts, working on the other side of ch, 1 dc in every ch, sl st to first dc. (12 sts)

Round 2: ch 1, [dc2tog] 6 times, sl st to first st.

Brake off yarn leaving approx. 15 cm tail, fold work in half so last rnd of heel is aligned, using a tapestry needle, sew the opening shut.
